# "Bridgetown" Team Race Regatta

## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing including appendix D, the US Sailing prescriptions, the ISSA Procedural Rules and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. US SAILING Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply and, under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied

## 2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all NWISA teams.
- 2.2 An adult who is responsible for the school's team must accompany the team to the regatta.
- 2.3 Schools may enter one team in the varsity division so long as all members meet the eligibility rules of ISSA PR1.2
- 2.4 If a school lacks sufficient sailors to form a complete team, teams may compete in the JV division by "mixing and matching" sailors from different schools. JV entry will be limited to the first 6 teams to register.

#### 3. REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 Teams may register by emailing Kyle Eaton at <a href="mailto:nwicsa@gmail.com">nwicsa@gmail.com</a> no later than April 15<sup>th</sup>. The accompanying entry and waiver forms may be submitted on Saturday the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$20 per sailor (includes lunch, dinner and snacks on Saturday and breakfast lunch and snacks on Sunday). Payment may be made at registration.
- 3.3 Parents and friends may purchase a meal ticket for \$11. One extra meal ticket will be included with each team's registration for a coach or chaperone.

#### 4. BOATS:

4.1 The varsity division will be sailed in club 420's. A second fleet of either C420's and/or FJ's may be used to accommodate a junior varsity fleet.

#### 5. FORMAT:

- 5.1. The regatta format for the varsity division will be a single round robin of all teams, followed by a double round robin of the top 4 teams. Win-Loss records for each team shall carry forward.
- 5.2. The JV division will sail a double round robin of all teams
- 5.3. If the above formats are not possible within the allotted time, the PRO and Chief Judge will announce the best course of action.
- 5.4. No incomplete rounds will be scored, but races sailed in an incomplete round may be used as tiebreakers.
- 5.5. Results of this regatta may be used to determine seeding for the Team Race District Championships on May 4-5.
- 5.6. In the event that the Team Race District Championships on May 4-5 are not completed, this event shall be used to determine the berth allocations to the ISSA Baker Trophy.

- **8. SAILING AREA AND COURSE:** Races will be held on the Willamette River between the Sellwood Bridge and the Ross Island Bridge. The preferred course will be a digital N; a port triangle may be used if conditions necessitate.
- 9. SCORING: Races will be scored in accordance with RRS Appendix D.
